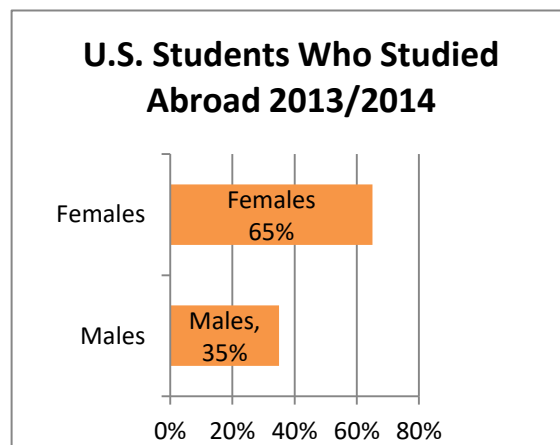


Fact Sheet

“65% of American college students who study abroad are women. Only 5% of Americans who study abroad are black” - Institute of International Education

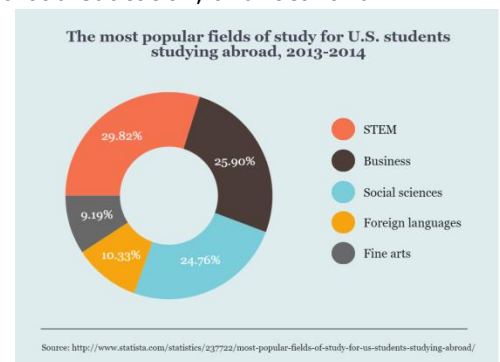


Through The Now Boarding Corporation students will be engaged in a one-of-a-kind travel program that offers them experiences that were previously out of reach. Selected students will engage in a year-long program that includes seminars on international travel, culture and lifestyle of selected destination, international business and cultural immersion in their home cities. By helping students obtain their first passport this organization will equip them with the first tool of many to embark on enhancing journeys.

STEM Travel

Through the Wanderlust Council selected students will have the opportunity to learn about the various benefits of cultural education, study abroad education, and local and international travel education. Monthly programming will also link travel to the student’s current high school curriculum using the core educational categories in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math). These tools will ensure that the student is being prepared both for college and future career paths.

Program Benefits: While monthly programming will include a number of educational aspects selected students will also have the opportunity to earn community service hours both locally and abroad. The Now Boarding Corporation will also partner with local museums, educational institutions and corporations, while guiding students through the entrepreneurial process of starting a new business.

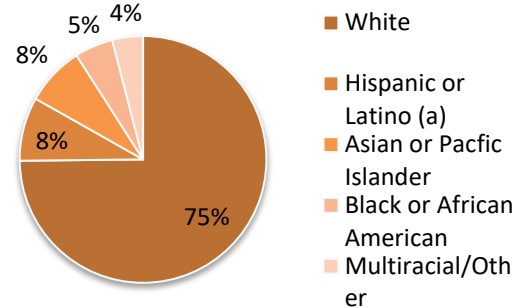


Benefits of Studying Abroad
